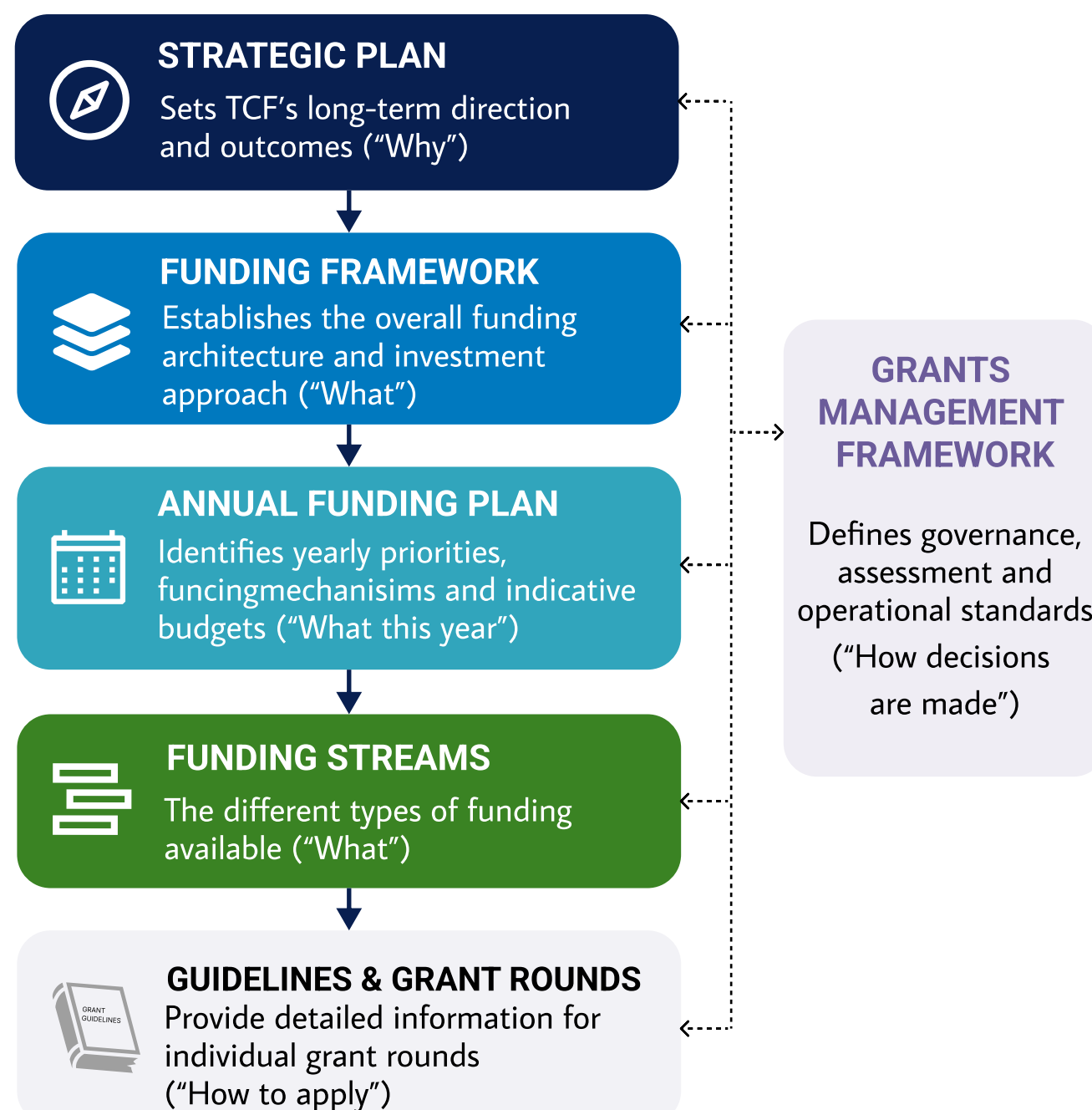
Supporting connected, resilient and thriving Tasmanian communities through clearer, more strategic funding.

 -  Improve governance, accountability and learning
 -  Support stronger outcomes for Tasmanian communities over time

	PURPOSE	TYPICAL SCALE
 MAJOR INITIATIVE GRANTS	Large, collaborative long-term initiatives addressing significant community challenges or opportunities.	Large / multi-year
 COMMUNITY ACTION GRANTS	Practical local projects that strengthen participation, inclusion and community life.	Small - medium
 CAPABILITY BUILDING GRANTS	Training, leadership and governance capability development.	Variable
 GRANTS IN FOCUS	Targeted funding responding to a specific issue, priority or population group.	Variable
